Anyone can edit the internet encyclopedia Wikipedia. The project was started in 2001 and Wikipedia is now one of the ten most visited sites in the world.

A Swedish version was started early, and it persists to be the eleventh biggest language edition of Wikipedia even though Swedish is only the 74th biggest language in the world. The Swedish edition of Wikipedia has been voted 'utility site of the year', in front of among others Nationalencyklopedin (the most common conventional encyclopedia in Swedish).

Wikipedia, the free encyclopedia,

- is the world's largest reference book ever with over 8 million articles, of which 2 million is in English (2007)
- is the fastest growing encyclopedia. Since the start in 2001, the size has been doubled every other year.
- is international, multi-lingual and boundary-exceeding.
- exists in 250 different languages. Swedish is one of the biggest language editions with 250 000 articles (2007).
- is free. The information can be spread and altered, since all contributors have given their permission according to the license agreement GFDL. This is not only free of charge, but also gives its users great freedom.
- is written by volunteers. You can also help! Does Wikipedia lack information about where you
 come from? You can contribute with your knowledge.
- is built on principles as impartiality, peer review, scientific methods and verifiability.
- is financed on voluntary contributions from generous persons as yourself.
